**SUBJECT: 2015 FIVE AND TEN YEAR AVERAGE GRAIN PRICES  
AND SUBSIDY PAYMENTS**

The Department of Revenue (Department) annually provides five-year and ten-year averages of wheat and barley prices for use by assessors. We also provide information about subsidies based on the earning or productive capacity of the land. The following information will be considered as the Department appraises land in the current use program for our 2016 ratio study.

### Wheat and Barley Prices

### Crop Rotation Subsidy Payments

The five- and ten-year average advantage for annual, two, and three-year crop rotation subsidy payments are calculated based on subsidy data from the [Farm Service Agency](#). The averages reflect zero subsidy payments for 2014 and 2015 due to the 2014 Farm Bill (Federal Agricultural Act of 2014) repeal of the Direct and Counter-Cyclical Program, which previously provided for subsidy payments. The Department will continue to monitor farm and agricultural land and the influence to value by programs administered by Farm Service Agency.
